SPORTSCENE

St A's 2011 Swimming Carnival

This will be held at the new PBC Pool this Friday 4 February for students aged 8 - 13 years (students in Year 2, turning 8 in 2011, have the option of attending). The carnival will start at 8:40am and finish at 2:45pm. All students in the relevant age groups are expected to attend with class roles taken on the day. For the carnival to run smoothly, we ask that all students be at the pool no later than 8:30am and be picked up at the above designated time. Students are to wear their sports uniform and House Colour hat - compulsory (available from Uniform Shop), bring along sunscreen, towel, rashshirt (optional, but recommended) and swimmers (one piece for girls and no boardshorts for boys), as well as 2 x drinkbottles. House Colour swimming caps will also be distributed on the day and must be worn during races.



A barbeque lunch will also be operational on the day for students and parents to purchase a sausage in bread as well as cakes, drinks and other goodies. Students are not permitted to go to the pool canteen while the carnival is in progress. Time will be given during the lunch break. Each House Colour held a meeting on Monday to organise nominations for each of the days events. Freestyle (either 25m or 50m – not both) will be the only compulsory stroke for the students. The remaining three strokes are only 50m events. All details were discussed with the students by our Year 7 leaders yesterday. Once again students were placed in either Torpedo (old A division) or Electric Eel races.

Students who finish with the fastest two times in all 50 metre races in the 10-13 years age divisions as well as Open 100m freestyle and 200m Individual Medley races, will progress to the District Carnival on Thursday 17 February.

Students who attend OHSC before and after school only this Friday will be able to catch the bus departing St A's at 8:20am and will return by 3:00pm from the pool.

In the event of heavy rain that may be predicted for Friday and cancellation is our only option, the carnival will be moved to next Wednesday 9 February. A decision will be made this Thursday afternoon (if need be) prior to students going home from school.

St A's Sports Carnival date changes for 2011

This year our school will be holding all three Inter-House sports carnivals in Term 1. Due to the Pan- Pacific Games being held this year, all schools find themselves in the position of selecting District squads much earlier than usual. Therefore, St A's dates in Term 1 are as follows:

GUIDANCE COUNSELLOR NEWS

After being away in an Acting Principal role for the second half of 2010, I am now back in the Guidance role at St Vincent's and St Augustine's ... special thanks to Nicole and Sandra who took on my responsibilities during that time.

For those new to the school, my name is Tony O'Shea and this is my ninth year in the role at St Augustine's and St Vincent's.

The purpose of the Guidance Counsellor role is to work collaboratively with members of the school community to promote and foster the social and emotional health of all the students. I work closely with the school leadership and staff and am available to assist parents, particularly in some of the following areas:

- Social or emotional issues.
- Behaviour management (school and home).
- Bullying concerns.
- Anxiety.
- Self-esteem.
- Friendship stresses.
- How to manage difficult situations.
-

I firmly believe that our children need to develop resilience to cope as well as they can with the demands of school and their lives generally. With this in mind, I regularly consult with teachers, other professionals and parents and am involved in the Student Support Team Meeting process. I work with whole classes on social skills development (specially designed games to develop social competencies) and am regularly involved in conducting formal and informal assessments.

Parents who have concerns about their child's social and/or emotional development can make contact with me through the class teacher, via email on aposhea@bne.catholic.edu.au, or by contacting the office. Referral forms are also available at the office. Please note that email is the most efficient way to get to me!

Some General Tips:

- Address concerns earlier rather than later.
- Try to validate your child's feelings, but adopt a problem-solving orientation.
- Be patient and tolerant of school staff, they are professionals and have our kids best interests at heart, but they too are human!
- Focus on the positive and model resilience yourself ... today's children tend to get too many negative impressions of the world.
- Avoid criticising the school or staff, particularly in front of your child ... there is no more effective way to create negativity for him/her about learning and education. Instead, if you perceive a problem, approach the appropriate staff member in a calm and constructive manner with the aim of clarifying the situation and seeking a solution.

As we embark on another exciting year of learning, growth and development for our children, let's not forget that there is no such thing as the perfect parent, nor the perfect child or teacher. We can all make a huge difference if we practise a little tolerance and patience and support one another (even when mistakes are made!).

Enjoy the 2011 school year, don't take it all too seriously and don't be afraid to seek help when you need it.
